A NACDS steering committee meeting was held at the Mebane's on Wednesday night, September 15th, 2004. Attendees were: Bryan Walls, Linda Harmon, Mark Mohon, Jerry & Carol Mebane and Doug Roth.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss plans for our Blue Moon dance weekend next May 20-22).

We covered: alternatives to the UAH University Center as venue. (The cost of using the UC will be about \$1300 more in 2005 than previously.) examination of a proposed budget with the new cost of the UC was made. Several options were explored including local School gyms, the gym at Faith Pres. etc. Eventually, we decided to stay with the UC, despite the increased cost.

It was announced that our original selection for a band, "Domino" is apparently no longer booking dates, and thus are not available. David Kaynor (see http://www.davidkaynor.com/) has been contacted and negotiations are proceeding for a 3-4 member band of his - perhaps called "Three Good Reasons" - to be our Saturday night band next May. Other band and caller possibilities were explored as well. The meeting broke up before hurricane Ivan arrived.

Contra Dance Designer

Among my duties as editor of the newsletter is the exploration of dance related websites. (It's a tough job, but somebody has to do it!) Anyway, I recently found one of interest.

The Seattle folk dance group has a page on their website that will allow you to create your own contras! You can pick from a list of over 200 dance figures, and put a dance together. Once you have a series of moves entered (using a simple interface) you can push a button and little colored symbols will swirl around and animate your dance!

They even have a couple of sample dances set up already. The first is an improper contra with a full hey-for-4. It's kinda fun to watch. The other dance lines up proper and then turns 1/4 circle right as if to get into becket formation. Very strange!

I'll warn you that the page only works with Internet Explorer. More secure browsers need not apply.
